Whereas, the County and municipal legislative bodies have ratified the Lincoln County Growth Plan as required by TCA 6-58-104; and


Whereas, the Lincoln County Coordinating Committee has held the requisite public hearings pursuant to TCA 6-58-104;


Dear Mr. Waller:

On April 28, 1999 the Local Government Planning Advisory Committee reviewed material you submitted in support of the Fayetteville-Lincoln County Industrial Board 's application for "sufficiently similar" status for the purposes of meeting the requirements of Public Chapter 1101. The Committee granted certification pending receipt of by-law amendments establishing that the Board meets the requirements of the greenbelt representation, mayor and county executive membership and an executive committee.




